### Impact Report

Happy Valley Elementary PTA hosted a **Free Book Fair** on February 28, 2025, for the school's 454 students. Over 35% of the school's families qualify for free or reduced lunch and we have students who are unhoused, in the foster care system, and living with food insecurity. This event was free to students and held during school hours, helping to increase access to books in the home. We collected donations of new and gently used children's books from community members and local organizations. We were overwhelmed by the generosity of our Bellingham community. This year, we collected **4,273 books**, over 1,000 more than we collected the previous year.




Figure 1. Books collected by type. Total: 4,273 books.



### Who the books served by grade




Figure 2. Number of books taken by students per grade.
